



## Islamic Academy of New England Second Grade Supply List 2009



These items will be labeled with your child's name to prevent the loss of his or her possessions.

(Please do not label ANY materials at home. Materials that do not meet the following criteria will be returned to you and new ones will need to be purchased from the store or Mrs. Boyle.)

- Backpack (preferably with wheels)
- Pencil box (plastic box,, no pouches please!)
- 1-inch (no larger!) sturdy 3-ring WHITE binder with clear cover (Recommended -1" Durable Round-Ring View Binder) (2)
- Folders (7, plain colors, no prongs/fasteners)
- Composition notebooks (3)
- Spiral notebooks (4 – you may reuse the religion notebook from last year!)
- Sketchpad – 8 x 11 inch or larger
- Ruler (hard plastic only, no metal or flexible plastic please!)
- Set of 5 dividers (2 packages)
- Book covers/BookSox (3)

These items should not be labeled, as all the students will use them:

- Clorox/Lysol Wipes (2 cans- no baby wipes)
- Tissues (3 boxes)
- Ziploc bags (any size, no slide zippers please)
- Paper towels (2 rolls)
- Pencils (2 dozen or more, yellow only, to be replenished as needed throughout the year)
- Large erasers (3)
- Crayons (24 pack)
- Color pencils (12 pack)
- Scissors
- Sharpener (1 – must have a cover)
- Highlighters (2 – yellow only)
- Lined Paper (2 packs – wide ruled)
- Construction paper (1 pack, large 12 x 18 in.)
- Index cards (2 pack, lined– white or color)
- Post-its (3 pads of 3 x 3 in., various colors)
- Hand sanitizer (1-2 bottles, no soap please!)
- Clipboard (8 ½ x 11, wooden)
- Markers (8-10 pack, wide, washable)
- Expo 2 Low odor dry erase markers
- Ballpoint pens (3 of each red, blue, black; no gel pens)
- Watercolor paint (1 tray)
- Manila drawing paper
- Glue sticks (6)

These additional supplies do not need to be purchased by every parent. Please select a few items to include with your child's supplies at the beginning of the year. There will also be a sign-up list at Back to School Night of the items we still need at that time.

- Student Dictionary (optional)
- Paper clips or binder clips
- 16 oz. bottles of washable paint
- Paintbrushes
- Printable mailing labels, various sizes
- Scotch transparent tape (clear)
- Packaging tape (clear)
- Masking tape (beige or blue)
- Chart paper
- Digital timer

- Foam balls (various sizes)
- Play-doh or clay
- Alphabet stamps for clay
- White plastic Solo plates
- Other art supplies (enough for the class)

Additionally, all girls are asked to bring a plain white hijab, in a labeled plastic Ziploc bag, to wear for prayers.
