Contest Rules and Guidelines:

1. For each grade, the assigned Sura for the contest is already part of the grade's Quran curriculum for the year, although it may not necessarily be the Sura being studied at the point of time of the contest period.
2. Upon entering the contest, a student is responsible for his/her own progress on memorizing the assigned Sura and knowing the relevant rules of tajweed (Al-Qalqala, Al-Madd, Noon Mushadada).
3. All students are encouraged to participate. However, only 5 students per grade will be selected to enter the final event on November 6th. Selection will be made by non-class Quran Teacher (eg. Sr Rachida's class will be judged by Sr Safia and vice-versa).
4. All students who participate (not only the finalist) will receive extra credits towards their Quran grade for the term, and will be awarded with certificates to acknowledge their participation.
5. In terms of **tie-breaker**, judges may test students on the following sura:
**1st Grade – Al Tarik, 2nd Grade – Al Insan (1st 15 ayah),
3rd Grade – Al Maarij, 4th Grade – As Saf, 5th Grade – Al Thariyat.**
